

Home Safety Precautions

As a resident of Greenbrier, you should be aware of certain precautions that will enhance your safety if you are approached by a stranger at your front door or on your property.



- Never open the door to anyone you do not recognize.
- If, at any time you feel threatened, call the Police immediately. (911)
- If you are approached in your yard, do not allow the person in your house. If you feel threatened, walk: to a neighbor's house.
- In the evening, keep inside lights on. Open the front door only after you turn on your outside lights and recognize the person at your door. Never open your door to a stranger.
- If you see suspicious activity in your neighborhood, do not hesitate to call the police department.
- Notify police and your neighbors when you are going to be away for any length of time. Do not allow papers, mail, etc. to accumulate.
- Place several lights throughout the house on timers. They will give the impression that you are at home.
- Finally, keep shrubbery away from the house, install motion detection lights, and keep your doors and windows locked.
